

New Login Information for Star Student Parent Portal

The way of logging into the Parent Portal has changed just a little bit with a recent upgrade.

- Go to the Blount County **Parent Resources** page:

- Click the same link: **Star Student for Parents**

- You *must* choose to “Continue to this website”, even though it says “not recommended”; if you are asked to “accept” or “install” a certificate, you should do so;
- The next screen is a Blount County Schools **Welcome** screen; a link to **Login** is in the upper right of the screen (see p. 2); Click the **Login** link to get to the sign-in screen;
- Your **User Name** and **Password** has not changed; be sure to include the “p050-“ in front of your user name; if you have not received a User Name and Password, contact your school;
- You should now be logged in and see the **Welcome** tab and your name,
- Click the **Parent/Guradian** tab; then click the **Student Info** link;

- If you have more than one student in Blount County Schools and cannot see all of your students on the Student Info page, contact your school(s) to get all of the student's linked; then you will be able to check all students' progress with only one password;
